The UW-Madison School of Education and the Education Outreach and Partnerships (EOP) office are pleased to offer a reduced tuition rate of \$193.20 per credit to strategic partners including schools, districts and agencies.

To be eligible for the \$193.20 per credit fee, educators must enroll in UW-Madison School of Education course(s) as a Special student (i.e., non-degree seeking student). Furthermore, all costs for delivering these courses are fully borne by external funding (e.g. grants, gifts, and/or the partnering school/district/agency).

A school district, school(s) or educational agency initiating a request needs to work closely with an academic department within the School of Education that will accept responsibility for assisting with the completion of the request form, serve as the sponsor for associated professional learning course(s), and carry out all related departmental responsibilities set forth in the attached guidelines and request form.

To ensure full consideration of a request, make sure that all assurances set forth in the guidelines and request form are satisfied. The guidelines and request form are available via request from Jenni Hart in EOP at jlhart@wisc.edu.
